Stakeholder wise Point of Satisfaction

Students Feedback

- ✓ Strong clarity in career goals and resilience in facing challenges.
- ✓ Practical exposure through projects, internships, and case studies highly appreciated.
- ✓ Leadership, teamwork, and communication skills developed well.
- ✓ Infrastructure rated as supportive and adequate compared to earlier years.

Alumni Feedback

- ✓ Alumni highlight strong decision-making, resilience, and problem-solving ability.
- ✓ High satisfaction with confidence, discipline, and professional development.
- ✓ Notable appreciation for teamwork, collaboration, and communication.

Parents' Feedback

- ✓ Parents observed strong improvement in decision-making, managerial ability, and discipline.

- ✓ Some alumni rated infra adequacy as average.
- ✓ Desire for deeper emphasis on innovation and creativity.
- ✓ A few noted scope to further strengthen leadership development.

Parents' Feedback

- ✓ A few concerns about infra adequacy and campus facilities (though mostly rated good/very good).
- ✓ Expectation for more structured parent–institute communication.

Employer Feedback

- ✓ Leadership qualities and decision-making under pressure rated slightly moderate.
- ✓ Innovation and creativity, though present, still need strengthening.
- ✓ Team collaboration and relationship building could be improved further.

Faculty Feedback

- ✓ Some felt infra and technology adequacy could be enhanced further.
- ✓ Scope to strengthen creativity and innovation more consistently across subjects.
