ARTICLE I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this MoU is to enable cooperation between PIBM and LACM for recognizing the role of the two institutions in the field of management education, management development and management consultancy, training, research and faculty development. The agreement will enable both the institutions to build institutional linkages and professional collaboration between each other.

ARTICLE II. SCOPE

The activities under the scope of this MoU are:

1. Training, education, research and consulting services in areas of mutual interest, particularly business administration, management and capacity building.
2. Management of training and development, especially: executive development programmes; top management seminars and colloquiums; and in-house management development programmes;
3. Management consultancy (including joint bidding for various jobs/assignments) in areas of mutual interest and institutional competency, with focus on: organization development, strategic management, human resource management, trainer development, financial management and procurement management;
4. Networking for information exchange, including exchange of PIBM and LACM research finding and publications;
5. Exchange visits by senior officials, faculty members and study tours by students / trainees.
6. Creation of opportunities for development of professional faculties and technical staff through training, research, consulting and related activities and exchange of expertise in areas of institutional competency and activities;

7. Design and undertaking of joint training programs and research consulting projects in areas of trainer development, executive development, organizational development, cross-cultural management, procurement management, faculty development etc;

ARTICLE III. DURATION, TERMINATION, AND AMENDMENT

1. This MoU will be effective from the date of signing by both parties up to a period of three years, and may be subject to extensions by mutual consent of the parties in writing.
2. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving three months advance notice in writing to the other party.
3. The provisions of this MoU may be amended at any time with the mutual consent of the Parties in writing.
4. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination, and expiration unless otherwise agreed upon between the parties.

ARTICLE IV. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. Modalities of each type of collaboration, associated activities and financial aspects shall be mutually agreed upon on a case-by-case basis in separate Memorandum of Agreements (MoA).
2. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be governed and construed under the laws of Nepal and Republic of India depending upon where the activities take place.
3. The two parties will consult with each other and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.




