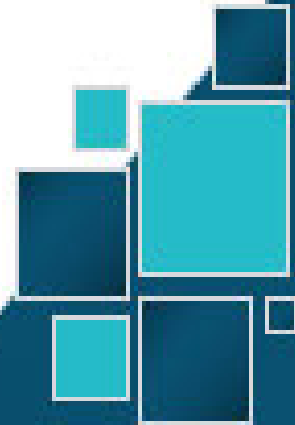

About the Program-

In the End-





About Event: PIBM had taken an initiative of organising Cleanliness Drive “Swatch Bharat Abhiyan” in outside campus area on 30th Nov 2022 with the agenda of making students realize the need of keeping the environment neat and clean. They covered various areas one of which include Lavasa link Road. With at most hygiene and safety they cleaned the area which was full of plastics and waste materials, and collected the dirt in the polybags. Around 30 students, 2 staff members and 2 house keeping people were involved in the process. The motive of PIBM to conduct this process is to create awareness between the students and the society to keep our surroundings clean, as most of the diseases comes from the waste materials which we throw randomly on streets or road.

PIBM as part of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan has taken various initiatives under CSR ensuring that a clean environment is created and maintained in all its business units as well as in the community at large. Some of the activities include taking Oath under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, participating in various cleanliness drives, participation in Alibhag Beach cleaning activities, etc



We started around 10am from college campus and travelled to Lavasa link Road by bus. After reaching the main spot, we put on our mask and hand gloves, for keeping self-hygiene. Then we divided ourselves into groups of 4 and started cleaning the area which was full of broken bottles and other waste materials. This shows the unity of students to serve the same motive of keeping the surrounding neat and clean. After completing the activity, we reached our campus at around 12pm.

This process helps to understand waste management and bringing about a behavioural change in people regarding healthy sanitation practices. As cleanliness is very important for the physical and mental growth. Hence keeping the environment neat and clean is a key to existence and survival of life in this planet. Students did their best to clean the area in a less amount of time with full dedication. 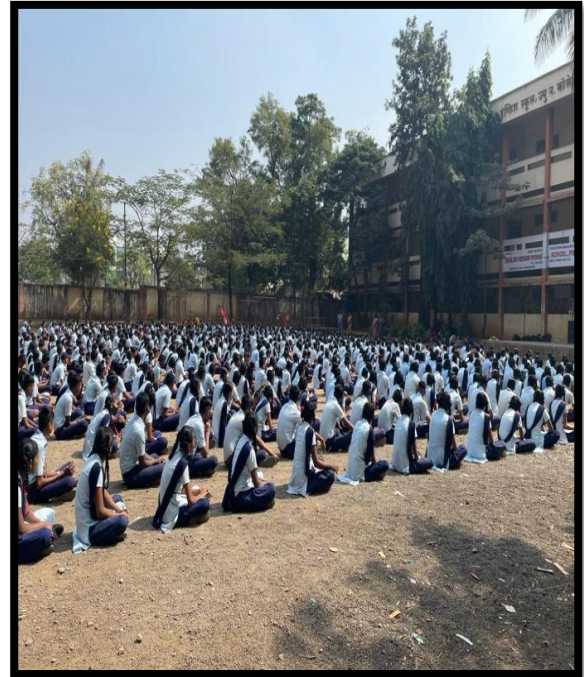


In the End

In New Digital & Social Media Age fraudsters have found several new ways to commit cybercrimes. The Internet is being used for various kinds of cybercrimes such as cheating women and children and sexually exploiting them.

These days Cyber Crime is a fast-growing area of crime. As, the technology is advancing man is becoming dependent on internet for all his/her needs as it gives easy access to do shopping, gaming, online studying, social networking, online matrimonial sites, online jobs etc. everything at one place.

This area of crime the risk is low and ROI is high & to catch these criminals is difficult. Hence, cybercrime is increasing all over the world. Many women in view social pressures & defamation do not come forward to report such crimes.

The Maharashtra government launched a 'Cyber Safe Women' campaign across the state on January 3, 2020, on the birth anniversary of Indian social reformer, Savitribai Phule. Sparrow conservation, recycling bicycles, plantation drives, marathons, cycling contests, clothes collection drives, waste segregation, yoga session, saving electricity, rainwater harvesting, minimal wastage of water, drip irrigation system for its large collection of more than 3000 plants inside the society.

Mr. Santosh Maskar, Chairman of the Roseland Cooperative Housing Society and Co-founder and Director of Sarvaha Systems Pvt Ltd Pune had described simple yet effective measures that can help change our habits towards a better environment-friendly individual, and conserve natural resources like water.

Mr. Anand Daptardar, Secretary, Roseland Society, Mr Sidharth Naik and Mr Ramakant Waghulade, Member, Roseland Society; and Mr Sarjerao, Manager, Roseland Society were present at the session. Each of them was associated with well-known corporates houses of Pune. Being specialists of

different fields, they brought collective strategies to make changes to their society in a more dependable manner.

As a result of their efforts, Roseland Society has been awarded The Green Society award by Radio City in Pune.

MEDA (Maharashtra Energy Development Agency) did an audit and awarded the society for its efforts to save water and conserve electricity.

Wipro in coordination with Nature forever awarded the society for its Sparrow Conservation project.

Regarding implementation of Rain water harvesting in the society experts shared their views about how it achieved tanker free status. In 2009, when the number of people in the Residency increased, the residents faced a water shortage. Two to three times a day water supply dropped down to once a day. The immediate and short-term remedy was to store water which they couldn't do for long and decided to do something about it.

The water from the terrace was collected and given to the borewell where it was recharged. This was done for one borewell at first. Following success in this pilot project, it was soon rolled out for the other borewells. In 2019 when society faced again water shortage they decided to accumulate rain water on open area in addition to terrace water by constructing recharge pit to harvest surface water, the constructed pit is around 9 ft x 12 ft x 13 ft deep

with filter built using big stones, sand and gravels along with network of pipes which is connected to small sump. This activity of rain water harvesting over the years has brought down hardness of water to less than 300 now.

Every drop of water saved counts experts said. Roseland society has since been encouraging the neighboring societies to adopt rain water harvesting as well. Experts guided PIBM representatives how to adopt & build rain water harvesting system on hilly area.

The experts shared in details the ways of managing and implementing flush water saving by the installation of dual flush tanks and empty plastic bottles, use of faucets on taps to save water. They urged students to take care of leaky taps to save water.

Initiatives taken to saving electricity, and implementation of segregation of three types of wastages at the source. The experts said that their efforts were also highly appreciated by the Government of India. They had identified secluded places within the society and used those places for building nests for sparrow conservation.

Also, bio-degradable waste management, was installed inside the society for the benefits of the 5000 residents. Manure is used for gardening in society.

Roseland Society has Zero Waste Model by way of 3 way Segregation & Collecting, Plastic & E-waste Recycling & Composting of Organic & Garden Waste.

Being an interactive, informative, and future-oriented session, the students actively participated in the discussion. Goonj a social initiative was discussed and they urged students to help the cause.

A few of students looked forward to their further support towards preparing research-oriented studies to better understand the model they had implemented at their society. At the end of the session, Mr Sidharth Naik urged the students to take a pledge based on the three R (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle).

He urged students to carry metal water bottles instead of a single-use plastic bottle and carry cloth bags to reduce use of single use plastics. These little efforts would bring a massive change to our environment and would make us more responsible human being.

Mamata Bal Sadan, an institution for the destitute orphans, has been founded in 1994 by the famous philanthropic lady Smt. Sindhutai Sapkal. The institute is located at Kumbharwalan, Tal. Purandar, Dist. Pune, Maharashtra.

The land for the institution is donated by Mr. Deepak Gaikwad, he is also instrumental in Bal Sadan, looking after management of daily affairs.

Today 52 destitute and neglected girls between the age group of 4 to 18 years are leaving in this institution. The shelter, ration, cloths, education, medical needs etc of these children are a responsibility shouldered by this institution; this work not only stops here but continues until these children become capable of living an independent and responsible life of their own.

Beside nurturing the children and motivate them completing their complete education, Mamata Bal Sadan probably is the only institution in the entire state of Maharashtra which also helps these children set up their own business after they are grown up.

Institute also strive hard getting financial aid available for such entrepreneurs. Training in agriculture, electricity, tailoring, cookery etc. is also imparted, so that these under- privileged children are able to earn their livelihood and live the lives of responsible citizens.

Ahead of this, once these children stand on their own feet, institute help them shape their personal life by finding proper alliances for them and arranges their marriages and sees that they are properly settled in life.

Guru Nanak Jayanti

Guru Nanak Jayanti, also known as Gurpurab, is the most important festival for the followers of the religion of Sikhism. It is celebrated to commemorate the birth anniversary of the first Sikh Guru, Guru Nanak Dev.

The festival is celebrated on the day of Kartik Poornima, which is the fifteenth lunar day in the month of Kartik according to the Hindu calendar, and usually falls in the month of November by the Gregorian calendar.

Guru Nanak Jayanti 2020: This year will mark the 551st birth anniversary of Guru Nanak and will be observed on Monday, November 30.

History of Guru Nanak Jayanti

Guru Nanak was born on April 15, 1469, at Rai Bhoi Ki Talwandi, near Lahore, which is in Sekhpura district of modern-day Pakistan. A Gurudwara was built at his birthplace in the city now known as Nankana Sahib.

It is located in the Punjab province of Pakistan. Guru Nanak is regarded as a spiritual teacher who founded Sikhism in the 15th century. He started writing the Guru Granth Sahib and completed 974 hymns.

The main verses from the Guru Granth Sahib elaborate that the creator of the universe was one. His verses also preach selfless service to humanity, prosperity and social justice for all, irrespective of differences. The role of a Guru as a spiritual and social master forms the base of Sikh religion.

Guru Nanak Jayanti celebrations

Celebrations start in Gurudwaras two days prior to the day of Guru Nanak Jayanti. A 48-hour non-stop recitation of the Guru Granth Sahib, called Akhand Path, is held.

A day before Guru Nanak's birthday, a procession called Nagarkirtan is organised. The procession is led by five men, referred to as the Panj Pyare, holding the Sikh triangular flag, Nishan Sahib.

The holy Guru Granth Sahib is placed in a palanquin during the procession. People sing hymns in groups and play traditional musical instruments and also display their martial art skills. The joyful procession passes through streets decorated with flags and flowers.

The amount was used to purchase 75 blankets and they were distributed to the needy people who dwell on the footpath. Areas covered were:

- Pune railway station
- Shivaji Nagar
- FC Road
- University Road

This initiative was headed by Manoj Singh Digwa, batch of 2019-21, and his friends and was under the supervision of Professor Fatema Abbas, HOD, Communication and Soft-skills Development.

They lack basic amenities, adequate infrastructure, adequate professional teachers, effective teaching aids and efficient school management etc. The drop out rate among the girls is greater than the boys.

The main reason for drop out is the stagnation i.e children repeating same class again. The other contributing reasons to this are Poverty, Unemployment, and discrimination on basis of caste,gender, race and other Social barriers.

In case of higher education, the no. of aspirants is greater than the availability of the seats in universities. However plenty of private

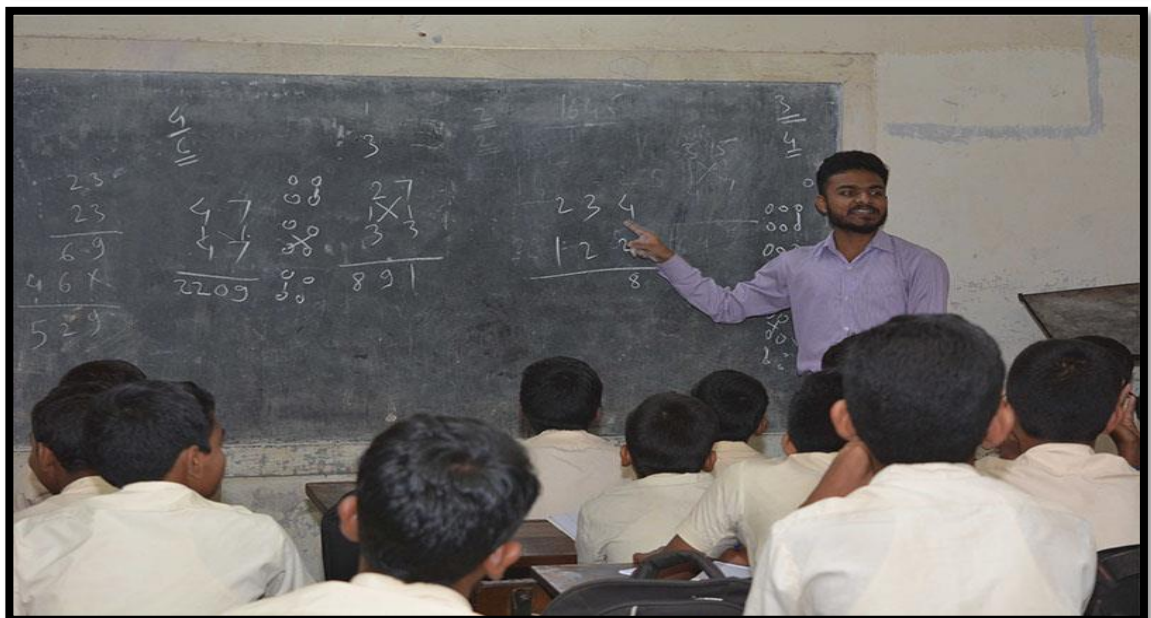
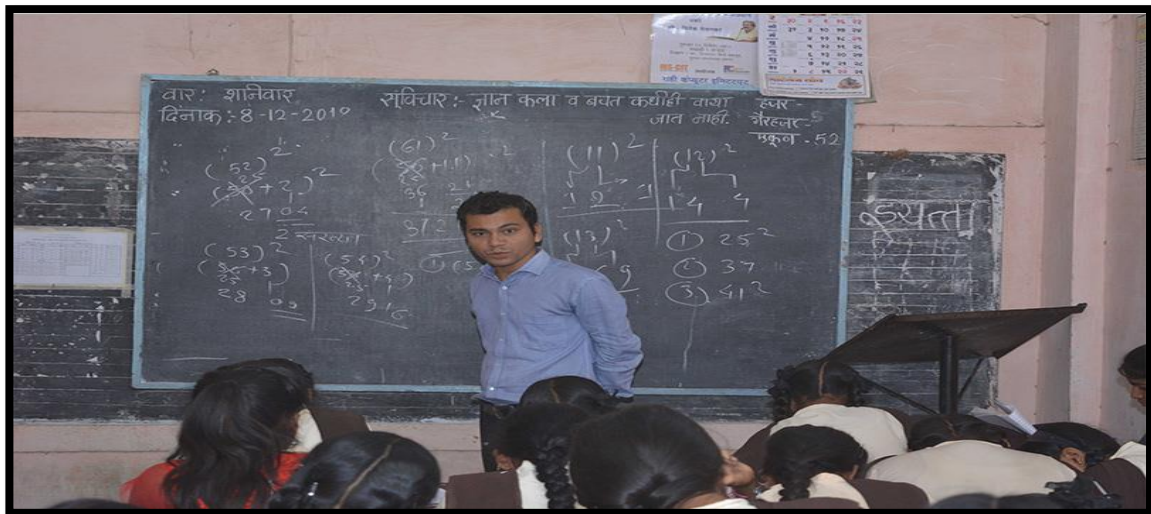
universities have been opened but the fees of such universities and colleges are very high that lower income group student cannot afford. The governments have limited resources to tackle these problems; therefore, intervention of corporate sector in education is needed. Organization's goodwill, its public image is also enhanced by its social responsibility

program. According to a survey, people tend to buy a product more if it is associated with any CSR program.

Other CSR practices for the education sector that are increasingly gaining popularity among specific industries include the promotion of computer illiteracy, establishment of gender equity by targeting girls from economically disadvantaged families for quality education, provision of toilets and maintenance of a clean and hygienic school environment, customization of programs designed to provide educational support to children with disabilities, provision of nourishment to students, psychological support to

underprivileged students by providing motivational talks on leadership development, personality development, establishment of training institute for teachers, libraries for rural school education of slum children and night schools for uneducated adults for empowerment of illiterate public in surrounding villages, tribal areas. The session was facilitated by Dr. Chetna N. Mehta and the participating trainers were Prof. Amitkumar Naik & Prof. Dinesh Dhakate.

Core topics that were covered were Average, Percentage, Roots, Fractions & Decimals. 60 students of 9th standard benefitted from this activity.
